I have made a table outlining what I am planning to put up on the website each week to make sure your learning is focused. At the moment I am only putting on plans for the next 6 weeks but your time at home may be shorter or longer. Please remember this is only a general overview and I may decide to change the focus of the week but I will always keep you informed if I do.

Parents: Please don't feel like you have to do everything on this sheet. Do as little or as much as you think is right for your child and give yourself plenty of time to adjust to learning at home.

Reading, playing, talking and spending time with your child is also very valuable.

Week 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths - Addition• English - Reading/listening to dragon stories and responding• Phonics - alternative pronunciations of 'ea' (like in bread and meat) and 'er'
Week 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths - Subtraction• English - Noun, verb and adjective spotting• Phonics - alternative pronunciations of 'a' (like in hat and bacon) and 'y' (like in yes, crystal and happy)
Week 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths - Money• English - Noun phrases• Phonics - reading and writing tricky words (many, laughed, because, different, any, eyes)
Week 4	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths - Time• English - Reading a poem/story and answering comprehension questions• Phonics - alternative pronunciations of 'ch' (like in church and school) and 'ou' (like in loud and you)
Week 5	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths - Multiplication• English - Features of a diary entry• Phonics - alternative pronunciations of 'ie' (like in pie and thief) and 'c' (like in coat and ice)
Week 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Maths - Division• English - Write your own story• Phonics - reading and writing tricky words (friends, once, please, water, thought)
