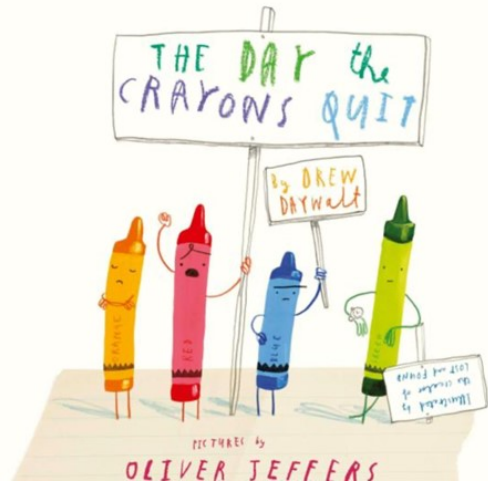


Rabbits Home Learning 22nd June

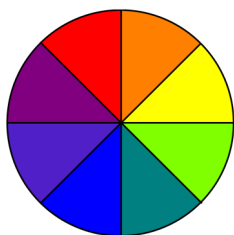
My Design
