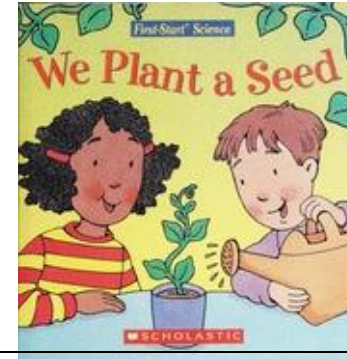

Instructional writing for Planting a seed.

Think carefully about writing instructions on how to plant a seed.

Look back at the list of sequencing words you made yesterday.

Can you use them to start each new sentence? Some of them you may want to use more than once.


Here is an example for Reception.

1. First get a pot
2. Put in the soil.
3. Next, add the seed.
4. Water it.

Here is an example for year 1.

1. First, get a pot and put in the soil.
2. Next, make a hole and add the seed.
3. Then cover the seed with soil.
4. After that, water the plant.
5. Finally put the pot on a windowsill.
6. Make sure that you water it daily.



<p>Reading and comprehension</p>	<p>Practise your reading and high frequency words daily. Practise reading the sounds in the middle of your reading diary. Talk through as many different stories, fiction and non-fiction books as possible. Pizza Massage

Get on your dancing shoes and follow the moves to the 'Dinosaur Stomp':



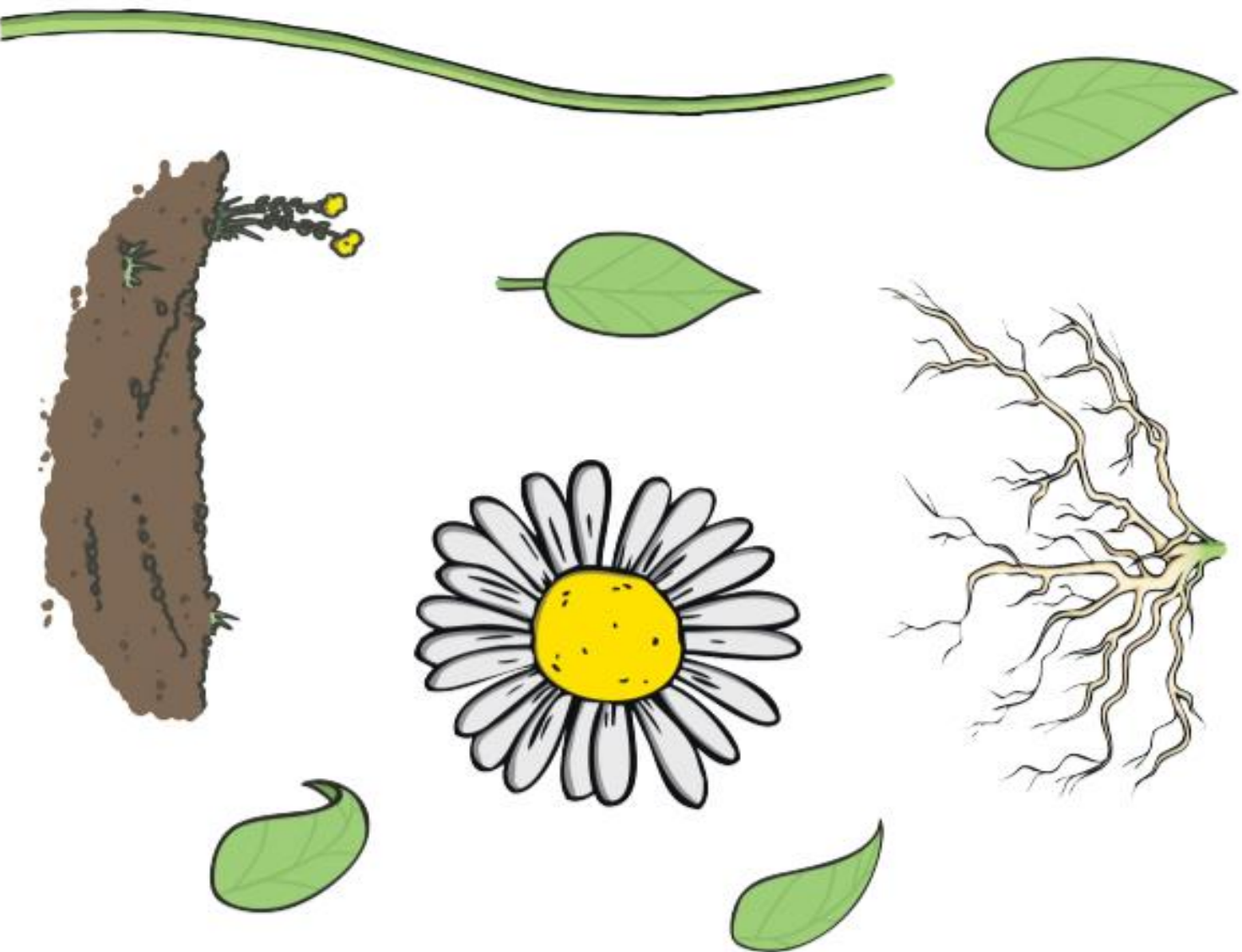

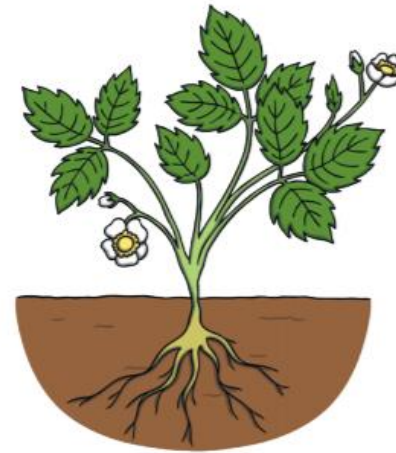

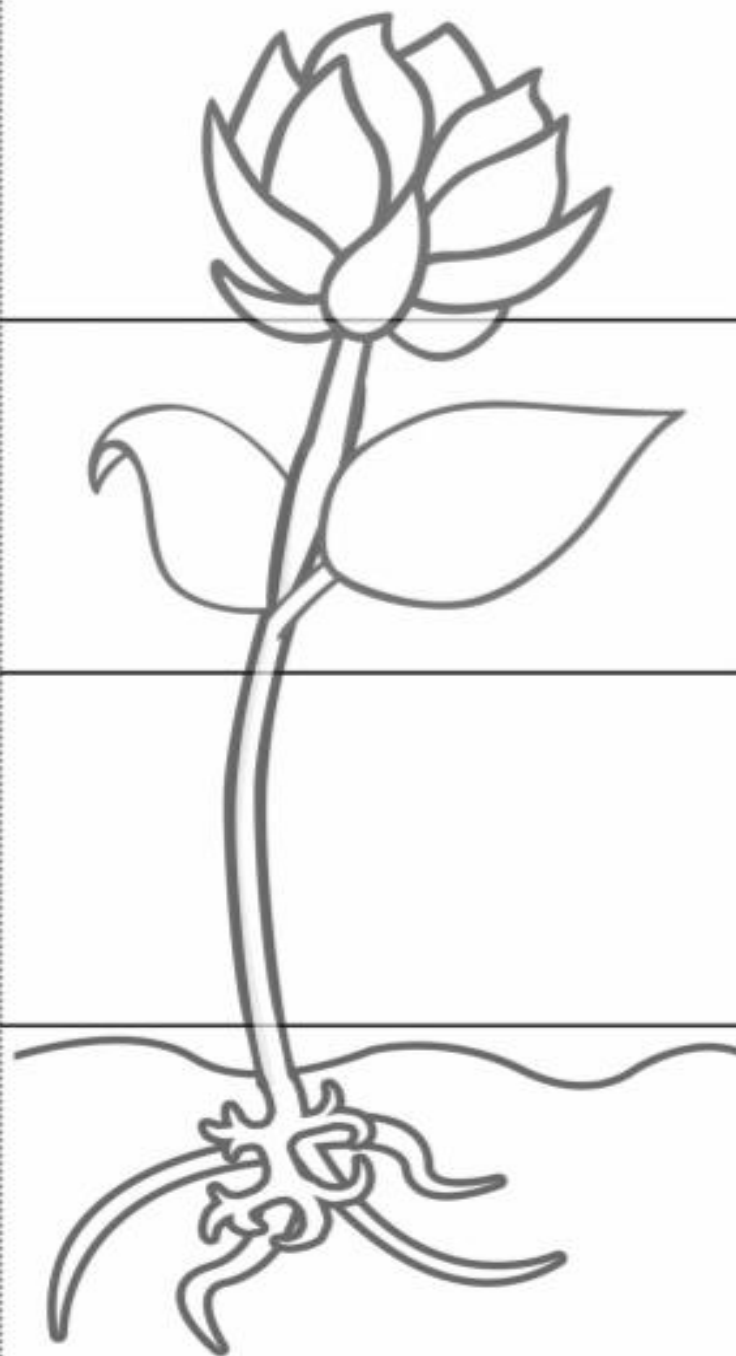
You can see that the pictures above show what a plant needs to grow and flower.
