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Behaviour Ethos

We believe that being at Hackwood should be an enjoyable and successful experience for all children so that everyone can reach their full potential.

We promote a calm and inclusive environment where children are supported to work and play together harmoniously. We promote the intrinsic desire to do the right thing and take pride in everything that we do. This means we support the children to understand their choices and to use a restorative approach to bring children back together into the group.

Our classrooms are calm and orderly but fun, with an emphasis on 'persevering' and taking risks with their learning. We value talk and support children to build strong, positive relationships with children and staff.

We have a weekly Achievers Assembly where certificates are awarded for children who have believed in themselves, achieved their targets and succeeded that week. In addition to this we have a half-termly Achievement Award for embodying the Hackwood Expectations consistently.

If a child is finding it hard to make the right choices, we support them by responding to their needs, working in partnership with parents to find a way forward.



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Uniform at Hackwood

We have Nursery provision for children for 15 hours or 30 hours (providing you have access to 30 hour funding).

For 30 hours the children will be here from 8:40 - 3:10pm daily

Reception, Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

Gates open: 8:40am

Register closes: 8:55am

Break times: 10:30am - 10:45am

Lunchtime: 11:30am - 1:00pm (each year group having 50 mins)

End of school: 3:10pm



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Lunches and Snacks



Fruit for morning break is provided free for all children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Children in Nursery on 15 hours can pay 50p a week to receive a healthy snack or bring their own and £1 a week for children on 30 hours.

Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 can bring their own fruit.



Milk is provided for all children until they reach the age of 5.

All children must have their own water bottle for use in school. This must only be used for water.



Delicious hot dinners are provided free for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.

Hot dinners can be purchased for Nursery and Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 for £2.64. All meals are to be paid for through ParentPay as we don't take cash in school.



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Before and after school provision



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We have provision for before and after school care for children. This will be onsite provision during term time only. Places can be booked using ParentPay and should be done 7 days in advance. Please note that availability is not guaranteed so please make a booking before cancelling other forms of childcare.

7:30am - 8:40am including breakfast and activities = £5

3:10pm - 6:00pm Activities and packed lunch snack = £10



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
