
Using Sumdog for 30 minutes a week almost doubled children's fluency progress

Our KS2 children have been busy all week competing on SUMDOG in our first contest with over 80 classes across the Harmony Trust! They have thoroughly enjoyed this and over the week have had lots and lots of success! WELL DONE KS2!



#### Makes learning fun!

Sumdog helps children to practise regularly. Combining fun games and achievements with curriculum-aligned questions, they won't even realise they're learning!

#### **Rewards effort**

For every correct answer, children are rewarded with coins to spend on their avatar or Sumdog house. And every time a child masters a new skill, their pet learns a new trick.

#### Adapts to your child


