Talking of reading this leads me onto our 2022 World Book Day at Hackwood!

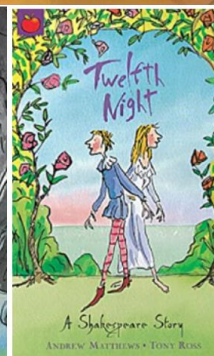
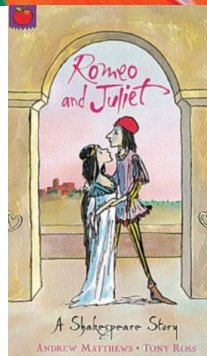
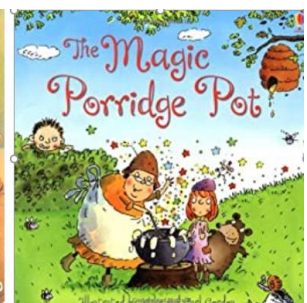
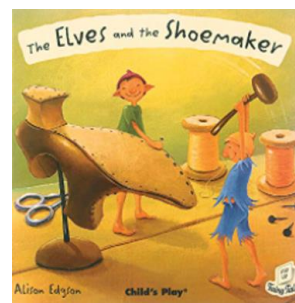
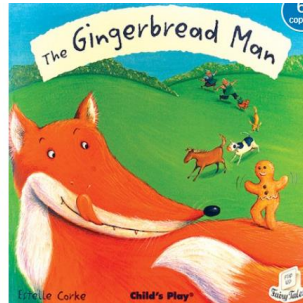
At Hackwood our World Book Day theme is...

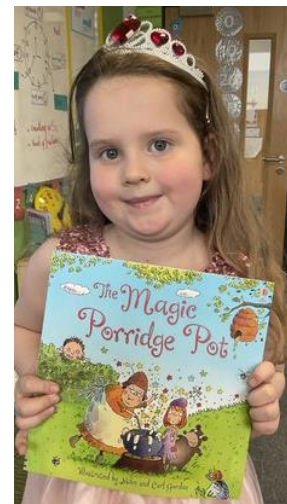
